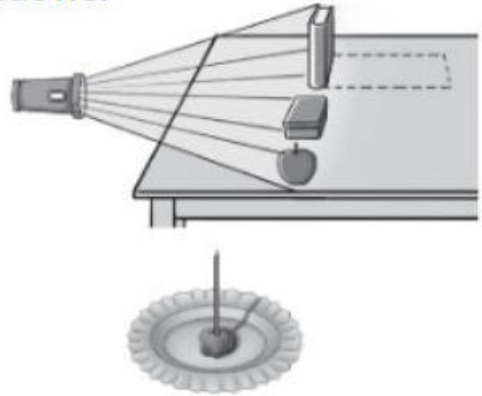

Draw the shadow on the diagram.

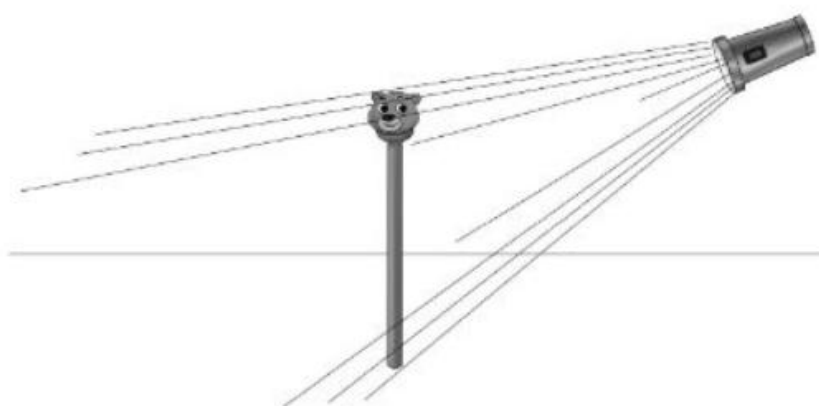


5 Draw the shadow in the evening.

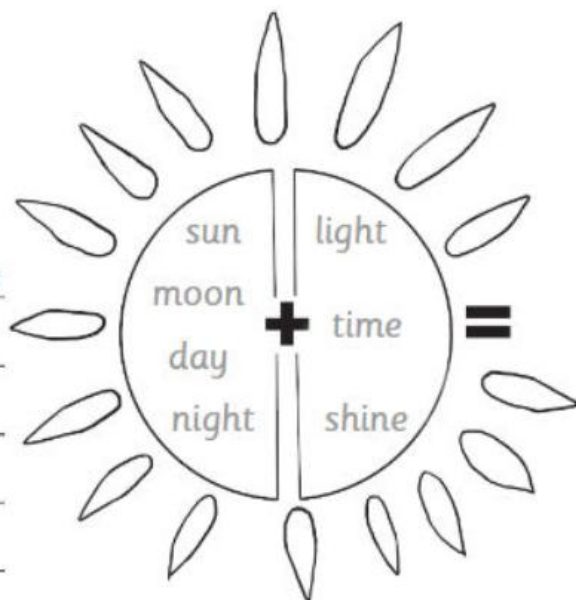
